Secretary

Communication with members:

- sends out the agenda of meetings to participants
- shares minutes of the meetings
- mails newsletters and other updates

The Secretary is an important link to German authorities like the association register, the notary etc. the applicant needs to be in command of the German language to an extent that enables him/her to produce documents which meet the requirements of German association law.

The Secretary takes minutes of all meetings: AGM, board meetings Steering Committee meetings and Strategic meetings

The Secretary keeps the member administration up to date.

Second Vice Chairperson

The Second Vice Chairperson has a position in the board of directors and in the Steering Committee of EBBD e.V.

Some of the details of the tasks of the Second Vice Chairperson:

The second Vice Chairperson takes care of marketing and communication activities for EBBD. This includes organising the EBBD newsletters and the communication through social media and the EBBD website.

The second Vice Chairperson supports the Secretary and Treasurer in their tasks.

In addition to these specific allocated tasks, the Secretary and the second Vice Chairperson actively contribute and participate in:

- online board meetings which are held every three weeks.
- Annual General Meeting and Training Event
- Strategic meetings organised twice a year which are in person meetings. One takes place adjacent to the AGM and the other at a later time in the year.

EBBD GRACE, an update of the European joint certificate in Business & Internationalisation – EBBD – with micro-credentials and GreenComp

EBBD is a joint European VET certificate of Excellence, with a focus on Business, Europe and Internationalisation, offered by almost 50 colleges, throughout Europe. As part of its ongoing evolution, EBBD is being updated through, EBBD GRACE, an Erasmus+ Cooperation Partnership. EBBD GRACE focuses on integrating sustainability competences based on the European framework GreenComp and on the implementation of micro-credentials issued as European Digital Credentials.

Objectives

- Update the EBBD certificate with green competences
- Provide more recognition of achievements for learners
- Increase recognition and value of the EBBD certificate in Europe
- Centralise and digitalise the issuing of the EBBD certificates

Recognition of Achievements Micro-credentials – European Digital Credentials for Learning





Micro-credential means the record of the learning outcomes that a learner has acquired following a small volume of learning. These learning outcomes will have been assessed against transparent and clearly defined criteria. Learning experiences leading to micro-credentials are designed to provide the learner with specific knowledge, skills and competences that respond to societal, personal, cultural or labour market needs. Micro-credentials are owned by the learner, can be shared and are portable. They may be stand-alone or combined into larger credentials. They are underpinned by quality assurance following agreed standards in the relevant sector or area of activity.
